We can make announcements over the tannoy on match days and we also offer the option to feature details in our match programme at the end of the season. Whilst we endeavour to accommodate family requests, it is the Club's policy that a minute's applause or silence and the wearing of black armbands are strictly reserved for Club Officials, Former Players, and those directed by the FA/EFL.

Unfortunately, the Club is no longer able to permit the burying/scattering of ashes at LNER Stadium or any training facility.

We have recently introduced a Memorial Wall at the LNER Stadium to provide a brick face for a lasting reminder of Imps who have passed away.
